- → In principle chose a forceps that will accomplish all the functions required for that case
- → Other criteria:
- Primiparity: forceps with overlapping shanks to minimize vulvar distension
  - ✓ Elliot forceps
  - ✓ Tucker-McLane forceps
  - ✓ Naegele forceps
- <u>Indication</u>

## **Prophylactic forceps:**

- → Rounded heads (i.e non-molded): (forceps with greater cephalic curvature)
  - ✓ Tucker-McLane forceps
  - ✓ Salas forceps
- → Modelled heads: (forceps with lesser cephalic curvature)
  - ✓ Simpson forceps
  - ✓ Elliot forceps

#### Correction of asynclitim:

- ✓ Salinas forceps
- ✓ Kielland forceps
- ✓ Luikard forceps
- ✓ Salas forceps

### Correction of deflexion:

✓ Any except for divergent forceps (Salinas, Salas, Laufe, Suzor)

#### Correction of malrotation disorders of the fetal head:

- ✓ Kielland forceps
- ✓ Salinas forceps
- ✓ Salas forceps
- ✓ Leff forceps
- ✓ Luikart forceps (for smaller degrees of malrotation)

### Aftercoming head of breech presentation:

- ✓ Laufe forceps
- ✓ Piper forceps
- ✓ Kielland forceps
