Decreased Platelet Production

- Inherited Disorders
 - Congenital amegakaryocytic thrombocytopenia
 - Thrombocytopenia absent radius
 - Wiskott-Aldridge syndrome
 - Fanconi Anemia
 - Dyskeratosis Congentia
- Acquired Disorders
 - Aplastic Anemia
 - Myelodysplasic syndrome
 - Infiltrative process- leukemias
 - Drug or radiation induced
 - Nutritional deficiencies (B12, folate)
- Sequestration
 - Hypersplenism
 - Burn Injury
 - Hypothermia

Increase Platelet Destruction

- NonImmune thrombocytopenias
 - Consumption due to Infection Sepsis
 - Bacterial, Viral, fungal
 - Microangiopathic disorders
 - TTP, HUS
 - Bone marrow transplant related microangiopathy
 - Heart Disease
 - Mechanial valve
- Immune-mediated thrombocytopenia
 - Acute and chronic ITP
 - Neonatal immune
 - Alloimmune
 - Autoimmune
 - Drug induced
 - Heparin-induced thrombocytopenia
 - Autoimmune disease
 - SLE
 - Autoimmune lymphoproliferative syndrome
 - Antiphospholipid antibody syndromes
